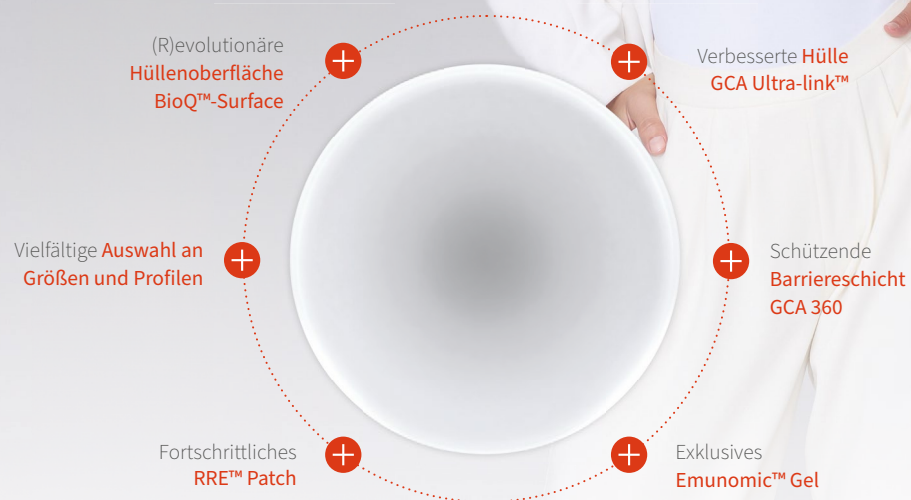
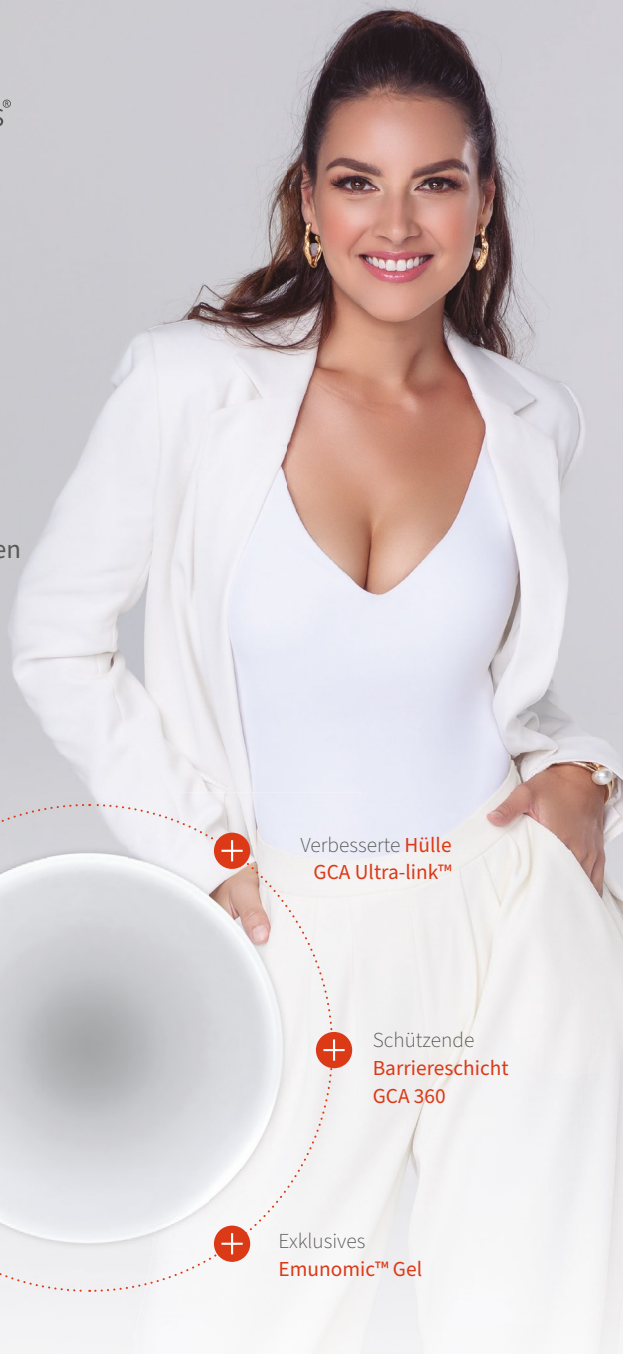

Evolution of free flap surgery in Switzerland: 1997 war das Hauptthema des Kongresses die Mikrochirurgie. Damals haben die Chefärzte der universitären Zentren über ihre zum Teil sehr spärlichen Erfahrungen in mikrochirurgischen Verfahren an ihren Zentren berichtet. Mittlerweile ist die rekonstruktive Mikrochirurgie zum alltäglichen Standard geworden, nicht nur an universitären, sondern auf sehr hohem Niveau auch an nichtuniversitären und an privaten Zentren. Es ist sicherlich nicht übertrieben festzuhalten, dass wir in der Schweiz im internationalen Vergleich zur Spitzenklasse in diesem Gebiet der plastischen Chirurgie aufgestiegen sind!

Das zweite Hauptthema, Device-related complications in reconstructive surgery. Dieses Thema ist bei der Eingabe von Präsentationen leider nur auf sehr wenig Echo gestossen.

Und schlussendlich das dritte Hauptthema: Facial volumisation: Dabei werden die pros and cons verschiedener Volumenaufbautechniken im Gesicht diskutiert.

Um die Attraktivität auch für unsere niedergelassenen Kolleginnen und Kollegen hochzuhalten, finden am Freitag und am Samstag zusätzlich Industrie-finanzierte Parallel-Sessionen statt mit dem Fokus ästhetische Medizin.

Zum Schluss bleibt mir nur zu sagen: die Landeshauptstadt erwartet uns. Ich freu mich auf euch!
